GMP is a three-generation, family-owned and operated business. Today's operation started with their visionary grandfather, who founded Barton's Butchery in Gundagai. His two sons built upon the knowledge passed down to them and in 1974, constructed a small abattoir on the outskirts of Gundagai where GMP stands today. Their facility now processes more than 750,000 Australian-grown lambs per year, making them one of the largest employers in the region.
